Athletes who engage in sports gambling often raises ethical and legal concerns. The NCAA has strict regulations prohibiting athletes from gambling on sports to maintain the integrity of the sport and many of our student-athletes at the NJCAA end up transferring to NCAA institutions so it is important we educate them on rules that could negatively impact their ability to transfer.

### CURRENT BYLAW

### PROPOSED NEW LANGUAGE / ADDITION

**NJCAA does not encourage or support sports gambling of any kind and supports the NCAA stance on Sports Gambling.**

- NCAA rules ban participation in sports betting activities and prohibit providing information to individuals involved in or associated with any type of sports betting activities concerning intercollegiate, amateur or professional athletics competition. In other words, if you are a student-athlete, coach or athletics staff member, regardless of sport or division, you are not allowed to bet or provide any useful information that can influence a bet in any sport the NCAA sponsors at any level.
